Our vision and mission

The Zoological Society of London (ZSL) is an international conservation charity, driven by science, working to restore wildlife in the UK and around the world. Our vision is a world where wildlife thrives and every role, every person in every corner of ZSL has one thing in common – we are all conservationists, and passionate about restoring wildlife.

Purpose of the role

The Sustainable Business Programme Manager shall lead ZSL's engagement with the business sector. The role delivers against the ZSL Conservation Policy to embed biodiversity at the heart of (corporate) decision-making and ultimately achieve ZSL's vision of 'a world where wildlife thrives'. The successful candidate will have a passion for driving change in corporate sustainability practices as a means of conserving nature.

This role is responsible for managing ZSL's Sustainable Business Programme and team of staff as well as collaborating across the society to leverage pro-biodiversity action by the business sector. This includes delivering a portfolio of conservation projects and advisory services aimed at reducing risk and enhancing benefits to biodiversity. The ideal candidate will have a proven track record in grant writing, fundraising and project management for programmes focused on private-sector sustainability and biodiversity conservation. Experience working with the forestry and agriculture sectors will be a benefit.

Key responsibilities

Strategy

- Oversee and periodically update the ZSL Sustainable Business strategy.
- Lead strategic alignment and collaboration with other departments within ZSL to engage business for pro-biodiversity outcomes

Fundraising and Business Development:

- Lead on fundraising for ZSL's sustainable business (& finance) project portfolio to maintain funding from existing sources and securing funding from new donors.
- Support business development for consultancy services to the business sector.
- Act as Key Account Manager for high impact clients and donors.
- Collaborate with other ZSL departments to seek funding opportunities engaging the business sector

Technical Service Delivery

- Provide leadership internally and externally on business-sector environmental and social sustainability issues and support engagement with business sector actors across the society.
- Provide technical support or lead on project and consultancy work related to sustainable business practices, including training, environmental, social and governance (ESG) assessments, field assessments, report writing, chairing meetings etc.
- Provide sustainability support services to companies operating in forest-risk commodity sectors. Including on legality due diligence, traceability, HCV/S approaches, deforestation monitoring, etc.
- Represent ZSL as part of relevant industry initiatives (e.g. RSPO, GPSNR, FSC working groups).
- Research and produce high quality technical outputs in the field of sustainable business practices.

Communications & Press

- Participate in press interviews, give presentations and contribute towards publications.
- Represent ZSL at key business sector events and relevant industry initiatives.

HR and Management

- Manage staff, consultants and external service contractors.
- Recruitment, selection, orientation and training of new employees (as required).

Finances, Operations and Risk Management

- Responsibility for financial sustainability of the Sustainable Business programme.
- Ensure effective budget management and delivery of activities.
- Ensure effective management of relevant parts of existing grants, ensuring that all programmatic and financial reporting targets are met.
- Maintain a robust and effective Monitoring, Evaluation & Learning (MEL) system for business sector engagement to inform changes to the programme operations and strategy

The duties and responsibilities described are not a comprehensive list and additional tasks may be assigned from time to time that are in line with the level of the role.
